There are two main reasons for supporting research in this area - one to save lives, the other is to improve the quality of life of patients who survive intensive care. Symptoms of survivors can include; post traumatic stress disorder, chronic pain and the social and emotional problems that can result in loss of jobs, depression, and stress on families.

What we do:

Develop new clinical research focused on direct patient benefit and supported by the intensive care community.

Support important pilot studies with funds and ICS members support.

Develop and refine new research ideas.

Support young intensive care professionals through grants and research support.

Over time, the Foundation expects to have a significant impact on the critically ill, saving more lives and enabling a higher quality of life after care.

The information supplied on this form will be held securely on file and on the Society's computerised database system. It will be used for contact purposes by the Society, analysis of the membership, and Society-regulated mailings. ICS eNewsletter, electronic communications - Members of the Society are kept up-to-date with important news relating to critical care and of the Societies activities by eNewsletter, email and information on the ICS website. This has a considerable cost saving to the society in administration, printing and postage and helps keep membership fees down.

Mailing and Marketing:

The society may receive requests from external bodies to send information of interest to its members. As they may provide a modest amount of additional income for the society, such requests may be forwarded by email or post to members, but only after they have been carefully checked and considered to be of interest and relevance by a member of Council. Members contact details will not be passed on to external bodies without authority.

Notes:

Applications for membership to the Society are presented to ICS Council for approval. Council meetings usually take place in January, March, May, July, September and November of each year. Candidates will be notified of Council's decision shortly after meetings. If successful, membership is effective from the date of approval.

Membership subscriptions are collected each year by Direct Debit for members with a UK bank account. Unless paid in advance*, Members' accounts will be debited for the annual subscription fee at the time of joining and following the issuing of annual subscription review notices. Members will be notified fourteen working days in advance of the money being collected from their account. Payment by Direct Debit is the most cost effective method for the Society to collect subscriptions and will help keep subscription rates down, so please complete the Direct Debit and return with this form.

* Individuals applying for membership and who wish to attend an ICS meeting before their application is approved by Council may pay the reduced member rate. However, in order to be entitled to the discounted rate, the first years membership fees **must be paid in advance of the meeting taking place**.

Overseas members without a UK bank account may pay their subscription by credit card. Please contact the ICS offices for a form.
